The Authority's accounts are subject to external audit by Mr M Searle of the Audit Commission, 1st Floor, Millbank Tower, Millbank, London SW1P 4HQ. Members of the public and local government electors have certain rights in the audit process:

1. From 18 July 2011 to 12 August 2011 between 10.00am and 5.00pm any person may inspect the accounts of the Authority for the year ended 31st March 2011 and certain related documents (comprising books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts) at the offices at which they are normally kept, or otherwise by arrangement. They may also make copies of the accounts and documents. Application should be made initially to the Head of Finance – NLWA, Lee Valley Technopark, Unit 161, Ashley Road, London N17 9LN or by telephoning 020 8489 5867 between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Fridays.
2. From 10.00am on 15 August 2011 until conclusion of the audit, a local government elector for the area of the Authority, or his/her representative, may ask the auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact the auditor at the address given above to make arrangements to ask any questions.
3. From 10.00am on 15 August 2011 until conclusion of the audit process, a local government elector for the area of the Authority, or his/her representative, may object to the Authority's accounts asking that the auditor issue a report in the public interest (under section 8 of the Audit Commission Act 1998) and/or apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law (under section 17 of the Audit Commission Act 1998). Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to me at the address given below.
