## **NORTH LONDON WASTE AUTHORITY – 11 FEBRUARY 2009**

### **1. Introduction**

- 1.1 The North London Waste Authority is one of two shareholders in the company LondonWaste Limited (LWL).
- 1.2 LWL holds its annual meeting in April/May every year and invites the Authority to vote at that meeting on various issues.
- 1.3 Last year, the three matters to be voted on as set out in the LWL Ltd notice of the meeting were as follows:
  - To receive and consider the financial statements for the period ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2007 together with the reports of the director and auditors thereon.
  - To re-appoint the auditors and to determine, or provide for the determination of, their remuneration.
  - To transact any other ordinary business of the company.
- 1.4 The Authority's representative can be a Member, an officer or someone else. However, appropriate notice must be given in advance to LWL to allow the representative to vote on the Authority's behalf.
- 1.5 In accordance with the Authority's Standing Orders, the matter of selection for attendance at this meeting as the Authority's representative was not one which had been reserved to Members. However, Members are legally able to appoint any proxy voter – and this could be a member of the Authority, an officer or somebody else. That person could then vote on behalf of the Authority either with a mandate or according to their own discretion.
- 1.6 Bearing this in mind, Members are asked to identify who they would wish to represent the Authority.
- 1.7 As the summons for the Annual General Meeting of LWL has not yet been issued, it is not possible for the NLWA to determine how votes should be cast on any issues to be considered, including the statement of accounts. Therefore, having determined who should represent the Authority at the meeting, the NLWA is asked also to agree that they vote at their discretion, following discussions with the Financial Adviser to the Authority.
