### WHAT DOES A TYPICAL DAY LOOK LIKE FOR YOU?

My day to day often varies, however there are some general tasks that I frequently undertake. Most mornings I start by reviewing data from our plant's continuous emissions monitoring systems (CEMS) to check our chimney gases have been staying within permitted levels. I also checking with other departments to see if any environmental issues or concerns have arisen in the last few days. My responsibilities generally include assisting to ensure our sites remain environmentally compliant and checking for any changes in environmental legislation the government may implement.



I have always loved the natural world and thinking about ways to preserve it. This led me to study Zoology at university and I went on to study a Masters in Conservation Science and Policy. Once I had finished studying, I worked with a small company who were developing on-shore wind and solar power. My next roles were both still within in the environmental sector, working on restoration projects and as a consultant. LondonEnergy then approached me with an opportunity to work as an environmental advisor.
